
Report 5362 – Individual Child Summer of Length of Consecutive Time in Foster Care

EXTRACTS(s)

-(1) CAP07362 -Clients are extracted if the following conditions are met:

1. the WKR-RGN-CD of the assigned worker (type “A” or “P” whose start and end dates include the current date) is not from region 8 (DOC)
- and 2. the placement type is ‘F’ or ‘J’ or ‘G’
- and 3. the number of days in placement is greater than 1
- and 4. the placement begin date is before the end of the report period
- and 5. the placement exit date is greater than or equal to the beginning of the report period

For each client that is extracted, the program reads his/her placement records until a “gap” in placement is found. (If the number of days between two placements is equal to 0 or 1, then the placements are considered to be consecutive. If the number of days between two placements is greater than 1, that is considered a gap in placement and the process stops for that client.) For each consecutive placement, the total days in placement is calculated for that placement and is added on to the running total. Once the gap in placement is reached or end of set is reached, the rpt-catg-flag is set based on the total days in placement count and is used to determine which report the client should appear on (see [report categories](#)):

- ‘3’ - if total days in placement less than 365 days
- ‘2’ - if total days in placement greater than or equal to 365 and less than 730 days
- ‘1’ - if total days in placement greater than or equal to 730 days

Information in the extract file is: (CAP07362-TRAN-REC-1)

Client Caps Id, Worker User Id, Worker Region Code, Worker Region Description, Worker County Code, Client Name Group, Days in Care Count, Client Race Code, Client Age, Report Category Flag, Worker Last Name, Worker First Name.

The extract file is sorted by Region Code, Report Category Flag, Client Last Name and Client First Name.

REPORT(s)

- **CAP05362** - This report reads the following transaction record:CAP07362-TRAN-REC-1 and produces the following quarterly report:

5362 - INDIVIDUAL CHILD SUMMARY OF LENGTH OF CONSECUTIVE TIME IN FOSTER CARE

This report will print a detail page for each Region and three Report Categories within the region. The three report categories are:

1. Children in Care Two Years or More
2. Children in Care One to Two Years
3. Other Children in Care (less than 1 year)

Report 5362 – Individual Child Summer of Length of Consecutive Time in Foster Care Main Extract

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The report contains the following information: Client Caps Id, Client Last Name, Client First Name, Client Ethnicity, Hispanic Origin, Client Age, Consecutive Days in Placement Count, Worker Id, and Worker Name. After the detail page prints for that category, a totals page will print for that Region/Report Category.

The totals are broken out into the number of clients by Age and Ethnicity. State totals are printed for each category at the end of the report.
