

## EVEL – Event List

This screen displays, in reverse chronological order, a history of events that have taken place on behalf of a specific client. For events that show two dates, the date on the first line is the date the action took place; the date on the second line is the date the worker entered on the screen.

**Field Descriptions** (F12) indicates code lookup is available.

### *CAPS ID* (F12)

Enter the CAPS ID of the client you wish to view event details for.

### *NAME*

This field will display the name of the client whose ID is entered in the CAPS ID field.

### *START FROM*

Enter a specific date in this field to narrow down the list of events. If a date is entered in this field, only events from that date to current date will display.

### *EVENT CODE* (F12)

Enter a specific event code in this field to narrow down the list of events. If a specific event code is entered in this field, only those events matching that code will display. Up to five event codes can be entered at one time.

### *DATE*

This field will display the date the worker updated the screen that created the event.

*EVENT CODE*

This field will display the event code identifier for the event.

*SUB CODE*

This field will display the event sub code identifier for the event.

*SCREEN NAME*

This field will display the screen that was updated that created the event.

*DESCRIPTION*

This field will display the description of the event. For events containing dates, the date within the description is the date the worker entered on the screen.
