The REMOVAL FROM HOME DATE field will no longer display.

The primary and other REASON FOR REMOVAL fields have been moved to the SERN (Service Detail: Non-Payable) screen.

The WILL THE CHILD BE RETURNED WITHIN 90 DAYS field will no longer display.

The PRIVATE PLACEMENT BY PERSON OR OTHER AGENCY field will no longer display.

When a new CREI screen is being created for the first time the EFFECTIVE DATE will default to the open date of the removal service. The END DATE will default to 99s.

The CONTRARY TO WELFARE LANGUAGE field (1) will display a "Y" (yes), "N" (no) or will be blank.

- ✚ If the CONTRARY TO WELFARE LANGUAGE field is marked with a "Y" or "N", the COURT ORDER EFFECTIVE DATE field will be required.

The REASONABLE EFFORTS HAVE BEEN MADE field (#2A) will display a “Y” (yes), “N” (no) or will be blank.

- ✚ This field will not be allowed to be marked with a “Y” or “N” if the CONTRARY TO WELFARE LANGUAGE field is blank.
- ✚ This field will not be allowed to be marked with a “Y” or “N” if the NO REASONABLE EFFORTS WERE REQUIRED field (#2B) is marked with a “Y” or “N”.
- ✚ If this field is marked with a “Y” or “N”, the COURT ORDER EFFECTIVE DATE field will be required.

The NO REASONABLE EFFORTS WERE REQUIRED field (#2B) will display a “Y” (yes), “N” (no) or will be blank.

- ✚ This field will not be allowed to be marked with a “Y” or “N” if the CONTRARY TO WELFARE LANGUAGE field is blank.
- ✚ This field will not be allowed to be marked with a “Y” or “N” if the REASONABLE EFFORTS HAVE BEEN MADE field (#2A) is marked with a “Y” or “N”.
- ✚ If this field is marked with a “Y” or “N”, the COURT ORDER EFFECTIVE DATE field will be required.

The VOLUNTARY INFORMATION field (#1) will display a “Y” (yes) or will be blank.

- ✚ This field will not be allowed to be marked with a “Y” if any of the LEGAL INFORMATION fields are marked with a “Y” or “N”.
- ✚ If this field is marked with a “Y”, the agreement type field (F12 lookup), start date and end date fields will be required.

Screen Protection

When a new CREI screen is added by pressing F11

- ✚ All fields will be blank and will be an enterable with the exception of the END DATE.
- ✚ The END DATE field will default to 99s and will be protected.
- ✚ The END DATE of the previous CREI screen will default to the EFFECTIVE DATE of the new CREI screen.

When the CONTRARY TO WELFARE LANGUAGE field is marked with a “Y”, the following fields will be protected unless otherwise noted. All other fields will be unprotected.

- ✚ EFFECTIVE DATE field
- ✚ END DATE field
- ✚ CONTRARY TO WELFARE LANGUAGE field
- ✚ CONTRARY TO WELFARE LANGUAGE COURT ORDER EFFECTIVE DATE field (Unprotected if blank)
- ✚ VOLUNTARY INFORMATION field
- ✚ VOLUNTARY INFORMATION START DATE field
- ✚ VOLUNTARY INFORMATION EXPIRATION DATE field

When modifying an existing CREI screen, if the following fields are blank then all fields are unprotected with the exception of the EFFECTIVE DATE and END DATE.

- ✚ CONTRARY TO WELFARE LANGUAGE field

- ✚ REASONABLE EFFORTS HAVE BEEN MADE field
- ✚ NO REASONABLE EFFORTS WERE REQUIRED field
- ✚ VOLUNTARY INFORMATION field

When modifying an existing CREI screen, all fields will be protected if

- ✚ The CONTRARY TO WELFARE LANGUAGE field is marked with an “N”.
- ✚ The REASONABLE EFFORTS HAVE BEEN MADE field is marked with a “Y” or “N”.
- ✚ The NO REASONABLE EFFORTS WERE REQUIRED field is marked with a “Y” or “N”.
- ✚ The VOLUNTARY INFORMATION field is marked with a “Y”.

When inquiring on an existing CREI screen, all fields will be protected.

Alerts

An alert will be sent to the all IVE unit worker (SCS staff type with the PLA supertask for the client’s county) ten days after the NO REASONABLE EFFORTS WERE REQUIRED COURT ORDER EFFECTIVE DATE saying that a permanency hearing is due in 20 days.

An alert will be sent to the all IVE unit worker (SCS staff type with the PLA supertask for the client’s county) and all SSI workers (SSI staff type with the PLA supertask for the client’s county) ten days prior to the parental agreement end date saying that the parental agreement is going to expire. (This alert will be deleted automatically if a new CREI screen is created with the CONTRARY TO WELFARE language field marked and the previous CREI screen contained parental agreement information.)
