

SCENARIO #1

- ASSOC DT is greater than an existing license association begin date and less than or equal to the license association end date.
 - There is an existing active license association with a begin date of 01/01/2009 and an end date of 99/99/9999. A new license is entered on PLAD with an ASSOC DT of 03/01/2009. The existing active license association end date will be changed to 02/28/2009.
 - A new active license association will be created with a begin date of 03/01/2009 and an end date of 99/99/9999.

SCENARIO #2

- ASSOC DT is less than or equal to an existing license association begin date.
 - There is an existing active license association with a begin date of 01/01/2009 and an end date of 99/99/9999. A new license is entered on PLAD with an ASSOC DT of 01/01/2009. The existing active license association will be made inactive.
 - A new active license association will be created with a begin date of 01/01/2009 and an end date of 99/99/9999.

SCENARIO #3

- ASSOC DT is less than or equal to an existing license association begin date.
 - There is an existing active license association with a begin date of 01/15/2009 and an end date of 02/28/2009. A new license is entered on PLAD with an ASSOC DT of 01/01/2009. The existing active license association will be made inactive.
 - A new active license association will be created with a begin date of 01/01/2009 and an end date of 99/99/9999.

SCENARIO #4

- License associated with placement hasn't changed but the ASSOC DT is changed to a date that is greater than the current ASSOC DT.
 - There is an existing active license association with a begin date of 01/01/2009 and an end date of 99/99/9999. A new license is entered on PLAD with an ASSOC DT of 03/01/2009. The existing active license association end date will be changed to 02/28/2009.
 - A new active license association will be created with a begin date of 03/01/2009 and an end date of 99/99/9999.

SCENARIO #4, continued...

- License associated with placement hasn't changed but the ASSOC DT is changed to a date that is greater than the current ASSOC DT.
 - The existing license is not changed on PLAD but the ASSOC DT is changed to 04/01/2009. The existing active license association from 01/01/2009 – 02/28/2009 and the active license association from 03/01/2009 – 99/99/9999 will be made inactive.
 - A new active license association will be created with a begin date of 01/01/2009 and an end date of 03/31/2009.
 - A new active license association will be created with a begin date of 04/01/2009 and an end date of 99/99/9999.

SCENARIO #5

- The active license association with an end date of 99/99/9999 will be end dated with the date entered in the placement exit date field when the placement is closed on PLAD.

IV-E Eligibility Determination

- The daily batch job and the retro batch job will look at all of the ACTIVE licenses associated to the placement to determine if the entire placement period was covered by a valid IV-E license.
