Field Descriptions (F12) indicates code lookup is available.

CAPS ID (F12)

Enter the CAPS ID of the person you wish to add or view interstate compact details for.

NAME

This field will display the name of the person whose ID is entered in the CAPS ID field.

SEL

Enter "I" (inquire) to inquire on an interstate compact application, "M" (modify) to modify an interstate compact application or "D" (delete) to delete an interstate compact application. *If the APRV CD field shows "A", only Central Office staff (SPJ staff type) can modify or delete the application.*

REQUEST DATE

This field will display the DATE OF REQUEST that was entered on the ICPD (Interstate Compact Detail) screen.

RESOURCE NAME

This field will display the name of the placement provider or placement person that was entered on the ICPD (Interstate Compact Detail) screen.

RECV STATE

This field will display the code for the receiving state that was entered on the ICPD (Interstate Compact Detail) screen.

MT CNTY (F12)

This field will display the Montana county code that was entered on the ICPD (Interstate Compact Detail) screen.

INIT RPT

This field will display the code for the type of initial report request that was entered on the ICPD (Interstate Compact Detail) screen.

APRV CD

This field will display "A" (approved) if the interstate compact application was approved or "D" (denied) if the interstate compact application was denied. *Approval/denial is entered by the Interstate Compact Coordinator in Central Office.*
